CSSP Requested Bridge Money: CSSP is asking to secure bridge funding immediately to complete a transition from OSD AT&L to OSD P&R until the program can be funded within the 2014 DoD Budget. These funds will allow the program to:

- Continue performing semi-annual updates to the deployment demographic maps for all currently serving members, OEF/OIF/OND veterans and recently separated Service Members and their dependents from the AD and RC of all Branches of Service.
 - CSSP just received data sets from DMDC thru 30 June 2012
 - Goal is to increase cooperation with the individual Service Strength Managers to confirm the data and move toward more dynamically updated and layered mapping products

- Continue to offer all of our courses and continuing education credits online for free.
- Continue working with other organizations to promote and track registration and completion of our CSSP online courses including:
 - AOS with an aggressive August 2012 campaign to target 50,000 providers in 10 states while continuing to promote our courses in all 50 states
 - White House Joining Forces and efforts like the 650,000 members of the National Association of Social Workers (NASW) announced last week
 - Health Resources and Services Agency (HRSA) and its partnership with the National AHEC Organization (NAO) to promote CSSP training online and through train-the-trainer events (Their goal is 10,000)
- Make incremental and modular adjustments to our current course offerings
- Expand our course offerings to deal with targeted populations like Dentists, Audiologists, Physician Assistants, Nurses, Military Mental Health First Aid (MMHFA), First Responders, Telemedicine
